Subject: NDAA Compliance and AxTraxPro Integration



As part of **Rosslare's** commitment to delivering secure and compliant solutions, we provide the following guidance on ensuring NDAA compliance when using AxTraxPro:

Non-Compliant Hardware

AxTraxPro video integration that incorporates non-NDAA-compliant hardware—such as Hikvision or Dahua cameras—is not suitable for use by federal agencies or contractors supplying equipment to these agencies.

Meeting NDAA Requirements

To achieve NDAA compliance, AxTraxPro must be used in conjunction with fully compatible third-party cameras that meet NDAA standards, if used as. The system retains full functionality and performance when paired with compliant cameras.

Recommended Steps for Compliance

1. **Replace Non-Compliant Cameras:** Identify and replace any non-compliant hardware within the AxTraxPro video integration setup.
2. **Verify Compliance:** Confirm the compliance status of cameras by consulting AxTraxPro's support team or referencing the list of approved NDAA-compliant cameras.
3. **Integrate Compliant Options:** Ensure that new cameras are seamlessly integrated into AxTraxPro for optimal performance while maintaining regulatory compliance.
